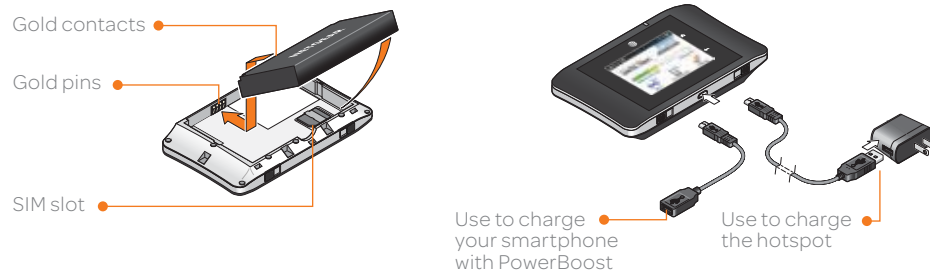


Quick Start



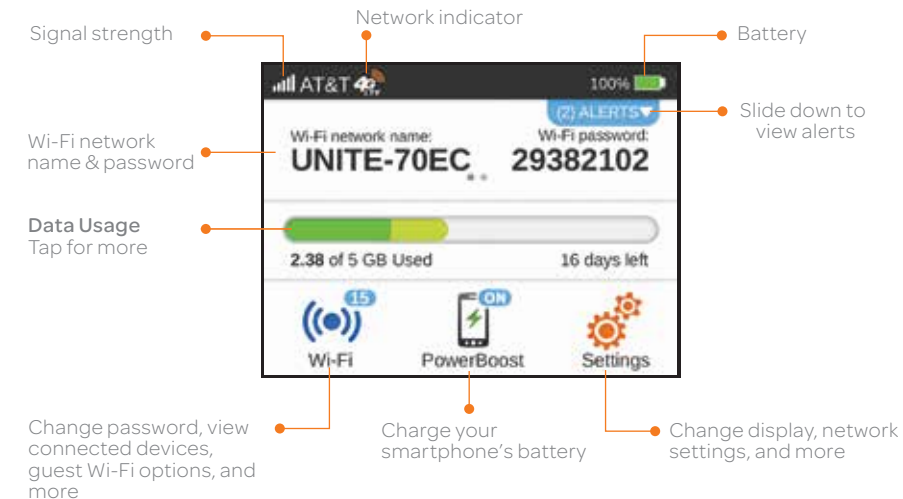
Set Up Your Mobile Hotspot

- ① Insert the pre-charged battery.
- ② Install the back cover.



Note: The mobile hotspot comes with a pre-installed SIM card.

Home Screen



Connect to the Internet

Turn on your Mobile Hotspot

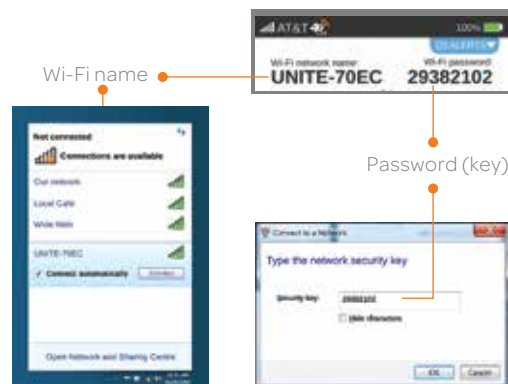
- ① Press and release the power button

Note: The home screen displays the hotspot's Wi-Fi network name and password.

On your laptop or other wireless devices

- ② Open your Wi-Fi/network connection manager.
- ③ Connect your device to the hotspot with the Wi-Fi name and password.

Note: The AT&T Unite Pro home screen goes dark to save power. Press and release the power button to wake the screen.



Basic Connection and Device Options

Change Wi-Fi settings



Wi-Fi

- Enable Dual-Band Wi-Fi
- Enable Guest Wi-Fi
- Change Main and Guest Wi-Fi names/password
- View connected devices
- Set maximum number of devices
- Read SMS messages



Change basic device settings



Settings

- Adjust screen timeout
- Adjust data connection settings
- Update software
- Find hotspot's wireless number
- Set Wi-Fi range
- Hide Wi-Fi network name and password



PowerBoost – Battery Backup on the Road

Use your mobile hotspot to charge your smartphone if its battery is low or out of power.

- ① Connect the PowerBoost cable to the mobile hotspot's charging port.
- ② Connect your smartphone's charging cable to the PowerBoost connector.
- ③ On the home screen, tap PowerBoost.
- ④ Select how long to boost (30/60/90 minutes).

Notes:

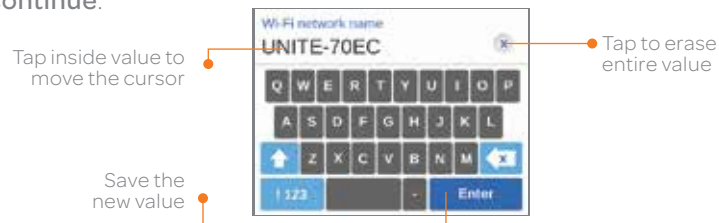
- To avoid depleting the hotspot's battery, the hotspot stops boosting when its battery reaches 10%. To restart boosting, go to step ③.
- You can't charge the hotspot while it is boosting your smartphone.



Wi-Fi Network Name and Password

Change Wi-Fi network name and password

- ① On the home screen, tap **Wi-Fi > Main Wi-Fi**.
- ② Tap **Edit** beside the name or password to be changed.
- ③ Tap **Continue**.



Hide password

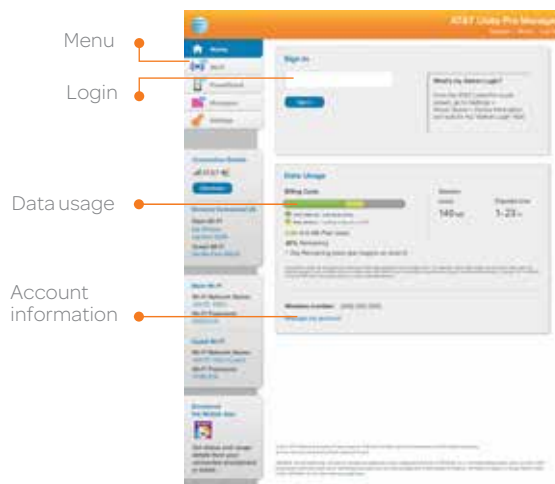
To prevent unauthorized users from seeing the password and using the hotspot connection, hide the password on the home screen:

- ① On the home screen, tap **Settings > Display**.
- ② Tap **Wi-Fi Info on Home Screen** and select **Hide**.

Advanced Settings – In your Browser

Access device information and settings via the AT&T Unite Pro Manager page from your connected device.

- ① Connect a Wi-Fi device to your mobile hotspot.
- ② Go to <http://attunitepro> in the connected device's browser.
- ③ Login is **attadmin**.



Advanced Connection Options

You can set the AT&T Unite Pro to enable either Dual-Band Wi-Fi or a Guest Wi-Fi network.

Dual-Band Wi-Fi

For faster throughput on compatible devices, use Dual-Band Wi-Fi (this may use more standby power).

- ① On the home screen, tap **Wi-Fi > Dual-Band Wi-Fi**.
- ② Tap **ON**. Connected compatible devices supporting 5GHz Wi-Fi will now have faster throughput.



Guest Wi-Fi

To let guests temporarily share your Wi-Fi without sharing your standard password:

- ① On the home screen, tap **Wi-Fi > Guest Wi-Fi**.
- ② Tap **ON**. Guests can now choose the Guest network in their connection manager.



Advanced Connection Options (continued)

Block device access

To prevent a device from reconnecting to the mobile hotspot, add it to the hotspot's blocked list:

- ① On the home screen, tap **Wi-Fi > Devices**.
- ② Select the device you want to block (there could be more than one page of connected devices).
- ③ Follow the displayed instructions to block the device.



Unblock a device

- ① On the home screen, tap **Wi-Fi > Devices > Blocked List**.
- ② Select the device to unblock, then tap **Unblock**.



Connect WPS devices

Use Wi-Fi Protected Setup (WPS) to connect WPS-enabled devices without entering the Wi-Fi password.

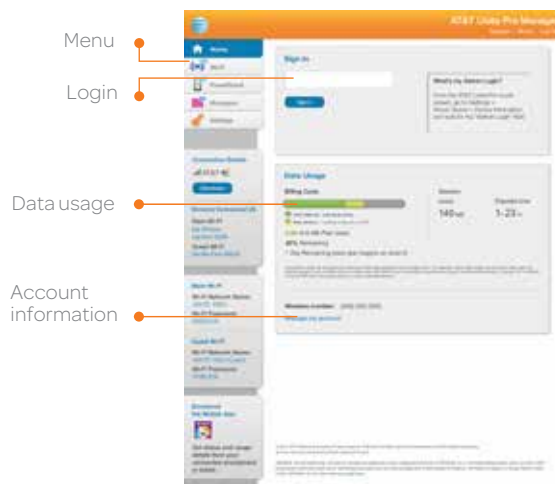
- ① On the home screen, tap **Wi-Fi > WPS** and select a pairing option.
- ② Press the WPS button on a device you want to connect to your mobile hotspot.



Advanced Settings – In your Browser



Access device information and settings via the AT&T Unite Pro Manager page from your connected device.

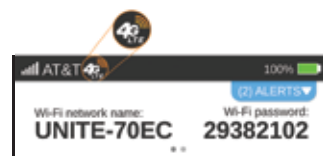
- ① Connect a Wi-Fi device to your mobile hotspot.
- ② Go to <http://attunitepro> in the connected device's browser.
- ③ Login is **attadmin**.



Network Indicators

Your 4G LTE wireless device will display one of the following network indicators to let you know which of AT&T's wireless networks you are connected to.

-  Connected to AT&T's 4G LTE network.
-  Connected to AT&T's HSPA+ network.

A network indicator does not necessarily mean that you will experience any particular upload or download data speeds.
